

## Kitty Kuranda Bed Cover

Cost: A few dollars

Time: 2 hours or so

Skill Level: Basic sewing knowledge

Finished size: 20 1/2" long x 15 1/2" wide  
13" long (3 sides) and 7" long (1 side)



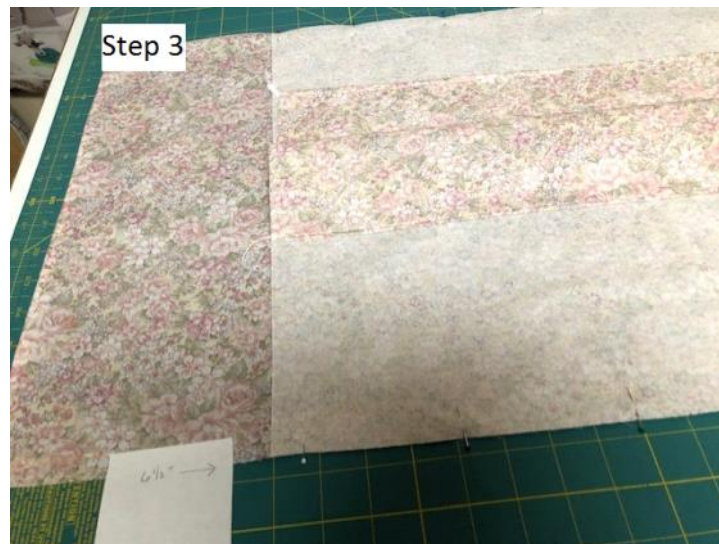
### Materials

- 1 yard Fabric (44" or wider) Cotton fabric
  - Sheets will also work
- Scissors, Sewing machine, Tape measure, Serger (optional)

**Directions:** General: Use 5/8" seams

1. **Cut.** Cut 1 piece of fabric 40" long by 15 1/2" wide (piece A)  
Cut 2 pieces of fabric 21" long x 14" wide (piece B)
2. **Sew.** Hem both short (15 1/2") sides of piece A. Hem one long edge (21" edge) on each piece B.  
To hem: Fold under the edges of the fabric 1/4", then again 1/4" so no raw edges can be seen on the hem.  
Alternatively, serge the raw edges then fold the fabric 1/4".

3. **Attach.** With right sides together, attach piece B (short piece) to piece A (long piece) 6 1/2" in from the left short edge of piece A.  
Repeat for remaining piece B on the opposite long side of piece A, aligning to first piece B.  
Sew (5/8" seam allowance).
4. **Press.** Press the pieces open.



5. **Sew.** To form the corners, meet the extended pieces of fabric at each end. You will make 4 corners (2 will be long - be sure to match the bottom hems - and 2 will be short - the bottom hems will not match).  
Stitch (5/8" seam allowance).
6. **Serge.** *Optional.* Serge the entire length of each side, continuing to serge the unfinished edge below the short side.



7. **Finish.** Finish the edges below the short side.  
Fold under the edges of the fabric 1/4", then again 1/4" so no raw edges can be seen on the hem.  
Alternatively, fold the fabric 1/4" if the edge was serged in step 6.
8. **Press.** Press the finished cover.
